CUT PRODUCTION WASTE

Reducing waste and improving production processes increases energy efficiency and production goals.

3 Keys to Discovery



BOOTS ON THE GROUND

Go to where the action is and involve the folks who work with the equipment and processes every day.



EYES ON THE DATA

Energy itself isn't visible, but we can make usage visible with data. Studying that data can help find opportunities that otherwise wouldn't meet the eye.



QUESTION ASSUMPTIONS

Be open to conversations with others and explore whether there is a new, more efficient way to get the job done!



TURN IT OFF

Equipment that's not doing useful work should be turned off.



FIX & TUNE

Equipment operates most efficiently when all components are working and properly tuned.



OPTIMIZE CONTROLS

Look to adjust equipment schedules, setpoints or sequencing to maximize efficiency.
